

Arrival at the Logierhaus

The total occupancy of the house is reduced. Guests are usually accommodated in double or triple rooms or, subject to consultation and availability, in single rooms.

All bathrooms are equipped with soap dispensers, surface disinfection and bath towels/towels, the beds are made up.

There are public disinfection dispensers at the following locations, which are checked daily for completeness:

- in the entrance area opposite reception
- in the entrance to the dining hall
- in the public toilets (ladies & gents)

For regular hand hygiene, the sanitary facilities in the room should be used; in addition, the public toilets are available.

Wearing a medical mask is compulsory in the public areas. Should a guest forget or even lose these, they can be purchased at the reception.

The ordinance of the state of Baden-Württemberg with a three-stage warning system applies; current situation reports can be found here.

Adolescents up to and including 17 years of age can be included in our testing strategy with rapid tests during a Music Academy stay, even without vaccination. In the warning and alert level, non-immunised, external adult day guests cannot participate in offers, events as well as meals in the Logierhaus. We adhere to our testing strategy even for those who are already immunised when staying at the Music Academy. Our hygiene measures were designed on the recommendation of and in consultation with the local health department and have proven successful over the past months. On arrival, a recognised negative test result, max. 24 hours old, must be presented and for longer stays, further rapid tests must be organised and carried out on site. The test days and the number of tests required can be found in your bed allocation plan. If it is not possible to arrive with a certified, daily updated rapid test result, in exceptional cases a self-test can be carried out under supervision in the guesthouse for a fee upon arrival after prior consultation. We have summarised the most important points regarding the currently valid corona regulations at the Music Academy Schloss Weikersheim, or what you need to know for planning your stay.

The group or course leaders are requested to draw up their own safety concept for the safe running of the rehearsals/event (including ventilation breaks) and to send it to the Music Academy secretariat before arrival.

Social evening activities are possible with restrictions. We provide our guest groups with separate venues with a small selection of drinks for the evening after rehearsals.

Guests who come from abroad or have stayed there for the last 10 days may arrive after consultation due to the entry and quarantine regulations, if this complies with the official requirements for entry from risk areas and they are symptom-free.

Persons for whom reasons for exclusion apply or who are affected by entry and quarantine regulations may not enter the Music Academy or participate in events of the Music Academy and the JMD. Anyone who cannot provide required proof, who has typical symptoms of an infection with the corona virus, namely shortness of breath, new-onset cough, fever, loss of smell or taste, who is subject to a segregation requirement in connection with the corona virus or who is not wearing a medical mask will be excluded. Access to the rooms of the Music Academy is not possible even with a medical exemption from the mask requirement. The group leaders must ensure before arrival that these persons are excluded from participation.

In addition, the group leaders will receive a bed allocation plan with available rooms for the agreed period of stay. All participants must provide their first and last name, address and telephone number as well as where they have stayed abroad in the last 10 days. With a declaration on the bed allocation plan, the group leader takes note of all official requirements as well as the house rules and hygiene rules of the Music Academy, takes care of the communication of the rules to the participants and is responsible for their implementation during the stay.

This data will be deleted after four weeks. The general regulations on the processing of personal data remain unaffected.

Arrival will take place at pre-arranged times. In case of delays, please inform us by phone at 0 79 34/99 29 40.

On site, the group/course leaders are asked to come alone to the reception, which is protected by a hygiene window.

Our staff will give you a verbal briefing and point out the rules of conduct that must be implemented by the group during the stay. These can be **downloaded from our website**.
